

As a follow-up, this fraudulent website continues to advertise itself as an "official" Olympic ticket site, please see the recent article below.

Also, I have additional evidence that the company behind it is undoubtedly fraudulent, including ticketing fraud during the World Cup in 2006. Notice that the website listed in the below BBC article (theonlineticketshop.com) has the same U.S. and U.K. registered address, and is basically the same company.

Their U.S. registered address is also fake, I have verified this with the building manager for the listed address (see attached email).
